- 1. What is the significance of a nameless Keeper? What is the significance of Ronan naming his beloved, and the "true" name she finds on the stone?
- 2. Why is the Lightkeeper difficult to see? Who in our lives "sees" us? Who are the nameless people in our lives we often fail to see?
- 3. Why does Wisdom tell the Lightkeeper to "remember what you have" when she is feeling hopeless? How has practicing gratitude worked in your life?
- 4. Do we only accept good from God and not trouble? Is our happiness a reflection of our material circumstances?
- 5. What does it mean that the suffering the Lightkeeper encountered was "for her"?
- 6. The Lightkeeper works "outside the home" and understands that time away is time she misses with her beloved, who also "needs" her. Have you had a similar experience? How do you deal with this tension in your life?
- 7. What does Wisdom mean that we cannot offer service to people without knowing them?
- 8. How does the Lightkeeper deal with the uncertainty of her life? Does she have more control or less after her decision is made?
- 9. When Ronan discovers the choice Aine has made he isn't sure if he would've made the same one. What do you think of the choice Aine makes?
- 10. What are the lighthouses in your life? For whom do you keep Lights?
